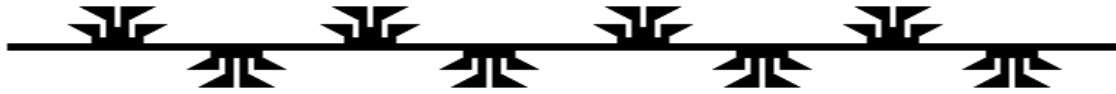

I understand that the Karuk Tribe does not provide any medical insurance or cover any charges my student may incur due to injury or illness while on this trip.

_____ (initials) I have read and signed the Karuk Tribe's Student Code of Conduct with my student. I understand that if my student violates any of the codes of conduct that I will be contacted to pick up my student and that any infractions will be dealt with according to Karuk Tribal Policy (if the violation warrants it, school disciplinary consequences will be enforced upon return to school, and law enforcement may also be notified).

_____ (initials) I understand my student will attend an overnight camp with chaperones who have passed a federal background check by the Karuk Tribe and have met the qualifications to work with minors under the Karuk Tribe's Personnel Policy.

Karuk Tribe Student Code of Conduct

Attendance at any Karuk Tribe sponsored activity is a privilege. The following conduct policy will apply to all students attending the **Yaas'araar Kúupha Summer Youth Gathering**, which is scheduled to take place **Tuesday, June 28TH (2:00PM) through Friday, July 1st (12pm) in HAPPY CAMP at the Karuk Ranch**. This form must be signed by each student attending the camp and submitted to **summeryouth@karuk.us** by **Thursday, May 26, 2022**.

Students will be representing the Karuk Tribe and shall abide by these expectations at all times to, during, and from the designated point of origin of the activity. Students shall respect and obey their designated chaperones and local authorities at all times.

Parents and students should review the following information carefully as students/parents are responsible for financial loss due to any of the following violations. Any questions may be directed to the coordinating Karuk Tribal Staff prior to the trip.

Code of Conduct Violations

Should a conduct code violation occur for items 1 through 8 below, regardless of when exposed, the violating student(s) will be sent home and will not be eligible to attend any other state, regional, or national events during the remainder of the school year. Severe violations may also cause the loss of title/office position and a permanent ban from Karuk youth events. If the violation warrants it, school disciplinary consequences will be enforced upon return to school, and law enforcement may also be notified.

1. **Alcohol, Drugs, and Tobacco:** A student shall not possess, purchase, sell, use, transmit, be under the influence of, or show evidence of having used an alcoholic beverage, other drugs, substances, or tobacco products capable of or intended, purported, or presumed to be capable of altering a student's mood, perception, behavior or judgment. Over-the-counter pain relievers and medications prescribed by a physician for an individual student and must be on record with the advisor. A student shall not possess, purchase, sell, use, or transmit paraphernalia associated with drugs, alcohol, or chemical substances in any form (including tobacco), at any time, or under any circumstances, on public or private properties.
2. **Willful Companionship:** A student shall not be in the willful companionship of someone who violates any portion of the conduct code. Failure to report any direct knowledge (other than hearsay) of the conduct code violations will be treated as equally as the violation itself.
3. **Personal Conduct:** A student shall not cheat, be dishonest, or take unfair advantage of others. A student shall not participate in social activities other than those specified within the event and with event participants. A student shall not be in possession of and/or conduct acts with weapons capable of causing bodily harm or fear of life, deface or steal any public or private property (for which financial responsibility will rest solely with offending individuals), and/or break the law. A student shall report accidents, injuries or illnesses immediately to the club advisor, keep adult advisors informed of activities and whereabouts at all times, and/or comply with established grievance process for disputes about competitive event results/processes (including personally confronting judges or event administrators). A student shall not have a member of the opposite sex in a room if no adult chaperone is present and the room door is not propped wide open, and/or have an advisor of the opposite sex in a room without a third person present and the door visibly open.
4. **Abusive Behavior and Lewd Conduct:** A student shall not engage in any lewd, indecent, sexual, or obscene

act or expression, or possess such materials. A student shall not engage in verbal, physical, or sexual harassment, hazing, or name-calling. The use of slurs against any person on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, ancestry, age, sex, sexual orientation, or disability is prohibited.

5. **Private Transportation:** A student shall not drive or ride in an automobile of an unauthorized driver. All adult drivers must be cleared with the Karuk Tribe by submitting volunteer and driver forms prior to the event.
6. **Public Conduct:** As a representative of the Karuk Tribe, a student will act appropriately at all times while traveling to and from the event, including in elevators, escalators, sidewalks, etc.
7. **Event Conduct:** A student shall not arrive or depart from the event outside designated times without the permission of the advisor. A student shall act in accordance to the code of conduct to, during, and from the event.
8. **Curfew:** A student shall not leave the assigned camping area from the curfew time designated by the advisor of the event. A student shall not cause any noise or other disturbance audible to anyone in the camp or participate in any other inappropriate activity after the designated curfew time.
9. **Communications Conduct:** A student shall abide by the rules for using electronic devices set by the Karuk Tribe.



Students- Please read and initial each statement and then sign.

_____ I understand that I am a representative of my Tribe, my school, my city, and that my behavior should be respectful and appropriate at all times.

_____ I promise to use the buddy system at the event and not to travel alone.

_____ I realize that it is a privilege to attend Karuk Tribe sponsored activities and that I will attend all events, be on time, and stay the entire time until I am released by my advisor.

_____ I understand that no alcohol or drug use will be tolerated.

_____ I understand that it is illegal for all high school students, regardless of age, to possess or use tobacco products at a school sponsored activity.

_____ I understand that items brought on the trip may be searched by the chaperones before and during the trip.

_____ I will not leave the camp without notifying my advisor, even with my parents.

_____ I understand that I must respect the property and land in which our events may take place.

_____ I understand that I am a guest of the Karuk Tribal Ranch and that my conduct must not infringe on the rights of the other guests.

_____ I agree to abide by set curfews. I understand this means being in assigned sleeping area by the curfew hour and remain there until the specified time.

_____ I will wear appropriate clothing to all activities.

_____ I understand that I am not to have guests visit me at any time during this event without my advisor's knowledge.

_____ I know that I am not to drive myself nor am I to ride in another student's vehicle to or from the event.

_____ I understand that my parents MUST attend all parent night meetings, if required, and all forms must be submitted/updated prior to the event.

I have read, understand, and initialed the above conduct contract, and I agree to follow it while on the trip. Any infractions will be dealt with according to Tribal Policy, and, with approval by the Karuk Tribal Council, and any relevant third parties.

Furthermore, I understand that my actions may affect my own future participation in Tribally sponsored activities.

Lastly, if I violate any of the above Code of Conduct rules, I understand that my parents/guardians will be contacted immediately and I will be sent home at my own expense and that my actions will be reported to my school administration.
